

# E-BIKE SAFETY



## KEY TYPES OF E-BIKES\*:

### Class 1 E-Bike:

Pedal assist up to 20 mph, no throttle.

### Class 2 E-Bike:

Throttle or push button up to 20 mph.

### Class 3 E-Bike:

Pedal assist up to 28 mph, no throttle.

## SAFETY TIPS:

Be 16+ to ride Class 3.

Wear a helmet on Class 3.  
(and under 18 on any e-bike)

Ride in bike lanes or paths where allowed.

All e-bikes must have pedals.

## KNOW THE RULES



Carry a valid driver's license or permit

Do not ride faster than 15 mph



Ride solo no passengers



Wear a helmet if you're under 18



Use bike lanes stay off sidewalks



Obey traffic signs and signals
